

## Wheels to Work

Wheels to work is a 'moped loan' scheme operated by RYECAT.

We loan mopeds to anyone over 16 year old who would otherwise be unable to get to work, training or further education.

RYECAT has a designated co-ordinator based in Selby District Community Transport.

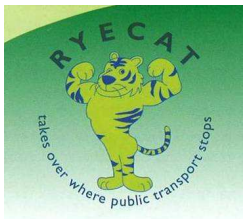
### Do I qualify to have a moped?

To find out get in touch with RYCAT. You will be interviewed by the Wheels to Work scheme co-ordinator who will assess whether you are eligible to join the scheme: the main criteria being

- *You are aged over 16 years old*
- *You are unable to get to your training /work by public or private transport.*
- *The distance would be too far to bicycle*
